These classes take place during the week, primarily on Wednesdays, and classes meet during the traditional school day. Homeschool Visual Arts

Ages 5-10	Students will create fun and exciting projects that connect them to their creativity and to the world around them.
Ages 11-17	Students in this class will learn about art history, create drawing and painting projects, and showcase their work in a feature exhibit at the end of each semester.

Homeschool Performing Arts

Ages 6-10	Students become part of the cast and crew of their very own production! Each semester features focus on a different show, and culminates in a public performance. Students will grow as performers while working to rehearse and prepare a show from start to finish.
Ages 11-17	Students will act, sing and dance their way through the semester in this musical theatre class! This class features collaboration with instructor and participants to create a unique story line for a culminating showcase performance.
