Facility

The majority of camps take place at Osceola Arts (2411 E Irlo Bronson Memorial Hwy in Kissimmee) Additional satellite camp locations include Valencia Campus Lake Nona & Valencia Campus Poinciana

Teaching Artists

All Instructors are screened through a background check. Instructors are theatre professionals and/or school district educators with extensive experience working with young people.



Instructors are present at check in for the first day of each camp.

Class Refund & Cancellation Policy

If a child leaves class after the first day, it is possible to receive a pro-rated refund. All refunds are processed through our box office. Refunds are credited back to your original form of payment. Credit vouchers may also be issued. Cancellation of the camp due to insufficient enrollment is made a minimum of one week prior to the first day. Osceola Arts reserves the right to alter or cancel scheduled classes as necessary. If a camp is cancelled, a full refund of the cancelled camp's deposit or tuition is issued.

Drop Off & Pick Up

Students may be dropped off 15 minutes prior to camp. We ask that parents/guardians come in with their camper on the first day of camp to check in and receive their car tag and confirmation emergency contact information. Pick up is between 3-4pm. Those picked up later than 15 minutes after camp ends may be subject to an added fee.

Pick Up Authorization

Anyone picking up a child must be on the approved list in the roster. Approved adults picking up children are **REQUIRED** to have either the car tag with their specific number or know the specific number to give our camp assistants at check out.



Final Showcase (Fridays)

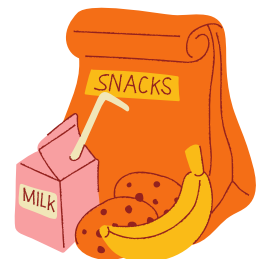
All camps and classes conclude with a showcase on the final day to which family and friends are cordially invited. The time and details of each showcase are sent out no later than 24 hours before the last day. Students may leave with their family after the showcase.

What to Wear & What to Bring

All classes involve a lot of movement. Your child should dress in shoes and clothes in which they can comfortably move. Dresses or skirts should be worn with leggings or shorts underneath, and sandals/flip-flops are not recommended. For all camps a closed toed shoe is required. Excessive jewelry is discouraged. If necessary, instructors will notify students if extra materials are needed for the camp. It is encouraged to leave electronic devices, toys or other personal valuables at home. Osceola Arts assumes no responsibility for lost personal items.

Snacks & Lunch

Campers should bring a non-perishable snack and lunch each day. Bottled water is recommended for water break, and drinking fountains are available on property. Please send healthy, easy-to-eat snacks. We are not equipped to refrigerate food or warm any food items.



Theatre Etiquette & Discipline Policy

- No food or drink during class, designated lunch & snack breaks are scheduled
- Students may not be in restricted areas unsupervised
- Students may not touch anything with which they are unfamiliar, such as machinery or props and costumes.
- Shoes must be worn at all times.
- Students should clean up after themselves, and throw garbage and recycling in proper receptacles
- Speak quietly and respectfully
- Safety is key; please be aware of where you are and what is going on around you
- Respect your classmates and their work
- Inappropriate language, disruptive behavior and/or insulting remarks, in and out of class, will not be tolerated.

Osceola Arts encourages a relaxed and creative atmosphere-- however, if a problem arises with a particular camper, appropriate disciplinary action is taken. The first step is to talk to the camper about the inappropriate behavior. Should the need arise, a conference will be called to discuss the child's behavior and their continuation in the program.

Sick children are asked to stay home. Basic first aid, such as adhesive bandages and ice packs, is available.
